The next Budget Committee meeting is scheduled for Monday, March 25, at 6:30 pm. This meeting will be held at the Central Office, and your attendance and participation are highly encouraged. Meetings can also be accessed online.

During this meeting, the Board will delve into various cost centers, including:

- 1. Region 8- Midcoast School of Technology: Discussing programs and services offered through our regional partnerships.
- 2. Athletics: Reviewing funding for sports programs.
- 3. *Technology:* Examining investments in technology infrastructure and resources for student learning.
- 4. Food Service: Addressing the budget for providing nutritious meals to our students.
- 5. *Transportation:* Discussing services for our students to ensure safe and reliable transportation.
- 6. Operations and Maintenance of Plant: Reviewing the budget for maintaining our school buildings and facilities.

These discussions are vital in ensuring that our budget aligns with our educational goals and priorities while also being fiscally responsible.

Medomak Valley Little League 2024

Registration Deadline: March 28th

Registration for Little League Baseball/Softball/T-Ball for Waldoboro and Friendship players will be accepted Monday-Thursday, 9 am-5 pm, at the Waldoboro Recreation Department until March 28th. Please do not wait until the last minute.... There will be a signup night at Friendship Village School from 5-6 pm Wednesday, March 20th. Another signup night will be held at the Waldoboro Town Office, Tuesday, March 19th from 5-6 pm. **The DEADLINE for registration in all divisions is Thursday, March 28th!**

Registration is required even if the child played previously. The registration fee is \$40. Scholarships are available upon request for those in need.

Eligibility birth dates are as follows: T-Ball/Baseball-- born between 9/1/11 & 8/31/20 and T-Ball/Softball--born between 1/1/2011 & 12/31/19. Divisions of play include: T-Ball (ages 4, 5 & 6 coed), Minor League Softball & Baseball (ages 6*-11 Coach & Player Pitch), Major League Softball & Baseball (ages 9-12). *League age six-year-olds wishing to play in the Minor League division must have played at least one year of T-ball.

To be selected for a Major League team, players (ages 9-12) MUST attend a tryout/evaluation session. Players that played on the WILDCATS, PANTHERS, HORNETS, WARRIORS or DIAMONDBACKS in **2023** need to register, but not tryout. This year's evaluations will be held at Medomak Valley High School Gym: Saturday, April 6th: Girls Softball (5-6:30 pm) & Boys Baseball (6:30-8 pm), and Sunday, April 7th: Girls Softball (5-6:30 pm).
