Many of you are familiar with our lack of space. We have music on the stage, interventions in the hallways, no classrooms for health or world language, and one Pre-K in the new building down the hill. In addition, we are expected to serve 3 and 4 year-olds in a couple of years.

School budget season is in full swing and there have been extended discussions about solving the space issue at Miller. In the Superintendent's budget presentation, found on slide 11 at this link, [presentation](#), you can find some options discussed. They include, but are not limited to, adding on to Miller School, moving Miller 6th grade to Medomak Middle School, and redistricting Miller students to another elementary school in RSU40.

None of these options is perfect and not everyone will be happy with the solution the Board determines.

The next Budget meeting in Monday, March 24 at 6:30 pm at the Central Office or online. If no budget is approved at that meeting another one is scheduled for Monday, March 31 at the same time and place. Discussion will also take place at the regular Board meeting Thursday, March 20 at 7:00PM at Medomak Middle School.
