Hello,

We're reaching out to share an incredible, **free** 2026 summer sleepaway camp opportunity at Camp Kieve for boys or Wavus Camp for girls!

For the past 100 years, [Camp Kieve](#) and [Wavus Camp](#), our wilderness tripping sleepaway camps located on Damariscotta Lake in Midcoast Maine, have been dedicated to helping campers grow in confidence, independence, and connection through time outdoors, shared responsibility, and community.

For summer 2026, we are partnering with Princeton University to support a study on the effects of camp on students currently in 5th, 6th, or 7th grade who have never attended sleepaway camp.

All interested students will be entered into a lottery that will randomly select **15 students** to receive a full scholarship (\$8,900) for a 3½-week (July 21-August 15) Kieve or Wavus experience, including financial support for necessary gear purchases and travel to camp. To enter the lottery, you must complete our camp application, two study permission forms, and three surveys over the next year (Summer 2026, Fall 2026, Spring 2027).

Each student who enters the lottery, and one parent/guardian, will be paid \$50 for each survey they complete, and a \$20 bonus for completing all three. This means that even students who are not selected in the lottery will receive \$170, and one parent/guardian will receive an additional \$170, for completing the study!

The study is focused on 5th through 7th graders: how they are sleeping, getting along with others, using time, handling school and home responsibilities, and thinking about the future. These are all aspects of life that camp can enhance — but in order to know, we need to ask and to study kids and families who do and do not attend camp.
