STUDENT SAFETY during Arrival and Dismissal

Arrival

- •8:30-8:45 Student Drop Off **Doors open at 8:30.**
 - oParents drop off students at the front entrance
- oParents will pull up to the curb in front of the school and students exit the vehicle. If your child cannot exit the vehicle quickly, please consider using the side parking lots.
- oPlease drop students off at the designated area and continue the flow of traffic. If you arrive when buses are here, please wait until they leave or you may drop students off in the side parking lots.
- **OVehicles will remain in place until all of the cars in front of them exit. Please do not pass other vehicles, unless a staff member signals you to do so.**

Dismissal

- •3:15 Parent pick up
 - •Cars will pull forward along the curb in order of arrival (<u>please no passing</u>) to wait for students to be dismissed. A staff member will be outside with a walkie talkie to let the office know who to call for dismissal.
 - <u>Vehicles will remain in place until all of the cars in front of them exit please do not pass.</u>
 - Parents may stay in their vehicles or assist their child(ren).
 - •Buses will be loaded after the cars have left the circle. Any parents arriving while loading buses need to park on the side.

We ask that parents please be patient while staff is assisting students to vehicles in the side parking lots. It is very dangerous for staff and students to have vehicles rushing to leave the school yard. Dismissal is a very quick procedure, if everyone is courteous and patient.
