

#### **REGARDING PICTURE ORDERS**

To do so, parents must go to www.strawbridge.net and use code FM459857 to find the proper event. All such online orders will ship for free to the school with the cash and check orders in 2-3 weeks. Those that have placed an order online do not need to turn in any printout to the photographer - as long as that parent got the order confirmation email and it's for the correct school/ correct Picture Day, we will match up the orders on our end. Beginning 10/27/2024, all online orders under this event code will be charged a late fee of \$7 and will ship to their home directly.


Students who earn a Panda High Five also receive 5 panda points and a feature in our newsletter to celebrate their hard work for the week.


