Students who earn a Panda High Five also receive 5 panda points and a feature in our newsletter to celebrate their hard work for the week.


We encourage our students to practice these habits both at school and at home, providing a wonderful opportunity for families to connect and reinforce these values together.

Please be sure your child comes to school prepared for outdoor recess. While there are occasional days students spend recess indoors, most days they are outside for a period of 30 minutes at lunchtime. We recommend that all students have appropriate outer-wear (jacket, snow pants, boots, hat, gloves/mittens). Please be sure to put your child's name on any labels. Black snow pants are hard to tell apart without the name. <u>All</u> <u>students are expected to go outside for recess when the</u> temperature, including wind chill, is above 10 degrees.

PICTURE RETAKES - December 5th

FOR RETAKES: There may be students that didn't like their original photo from Fall Picture Day. That's ok! They can take a complimentary retake on Makeup Picture Day. We ask that these students (and/or staff) bring their original, unwanted prints to the photographer on Makeup Picture Day. This serves 2 main purposes: I. The prints act as an identifier to their teacher that that student needs to be sent down to the photographer. II. It lets the photographer see what exactly wasn't liked about the Fall image, to help make the retake image even better. The students will be invited to review their retake image at the camera and can retake it again if needed. We will automatically reproduce their original order using the retake image, at no additional cost.
