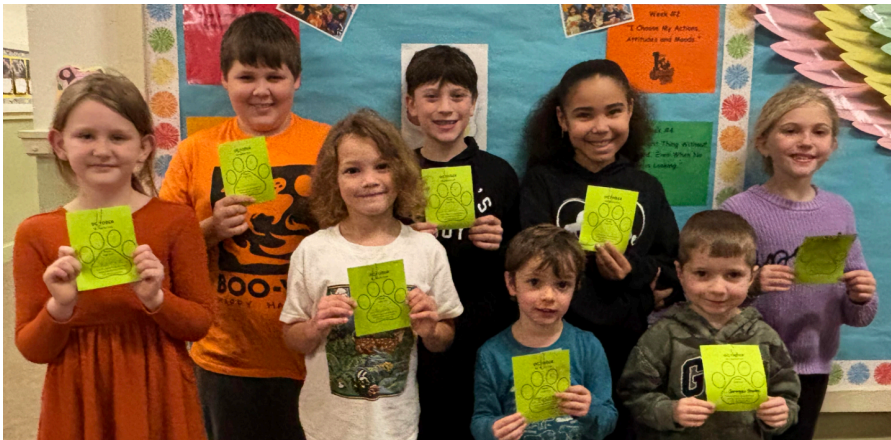


**POSITIVE BEHAVIOR AT PRESCOTT MEMORIAL SCHOOL**

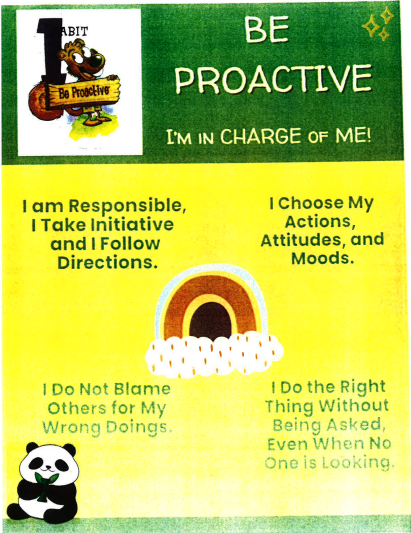

Food Assistance During the Government Shutdown


If you or your family are worried about food during the government shutdown, help is available.

- School Meals will Remain Available for All Students**  
All students can still get free breakfast and lunch at school every day.
- Find Local Food Assistance**

- General Assistance**

- Continue to Apply or Renew SNAP Benefits**


