COLD WEATHER ALERT

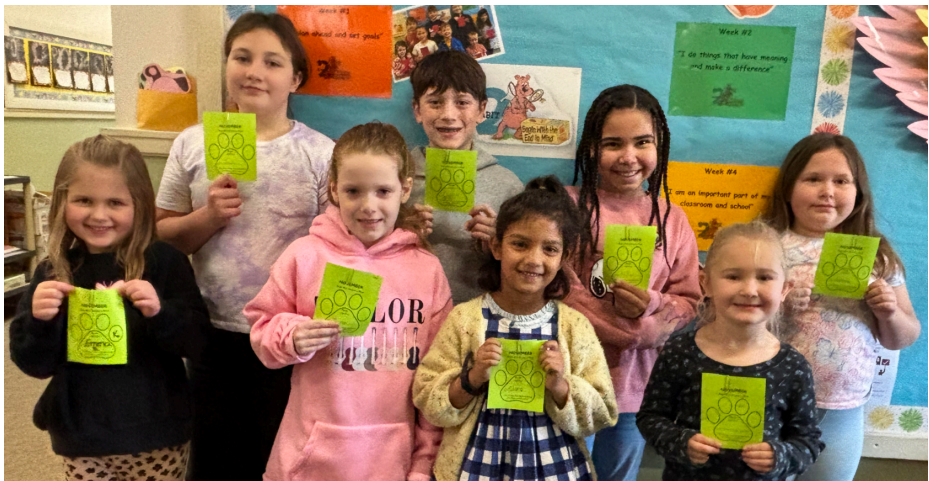
