YEARBOOKS

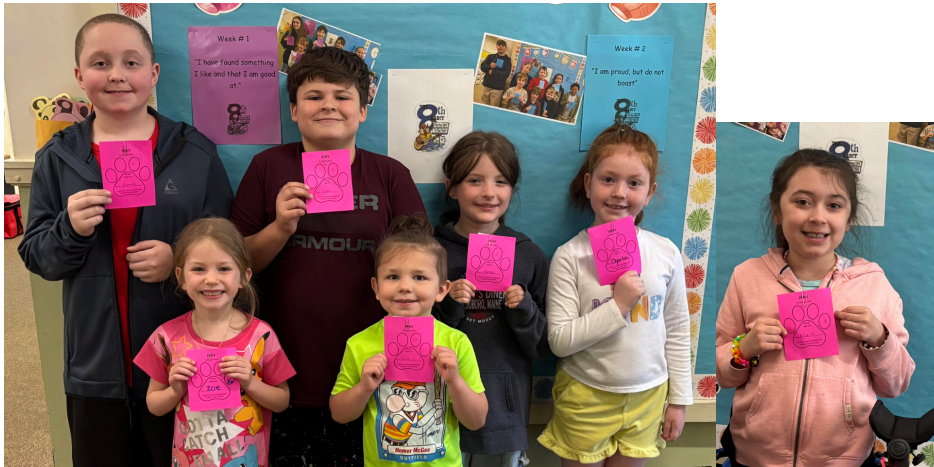

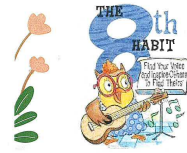
We encourage our students to practice these habits both at school and at home, providing a wonderful opportunity for families to connect and reinforce these values together.
