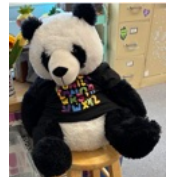

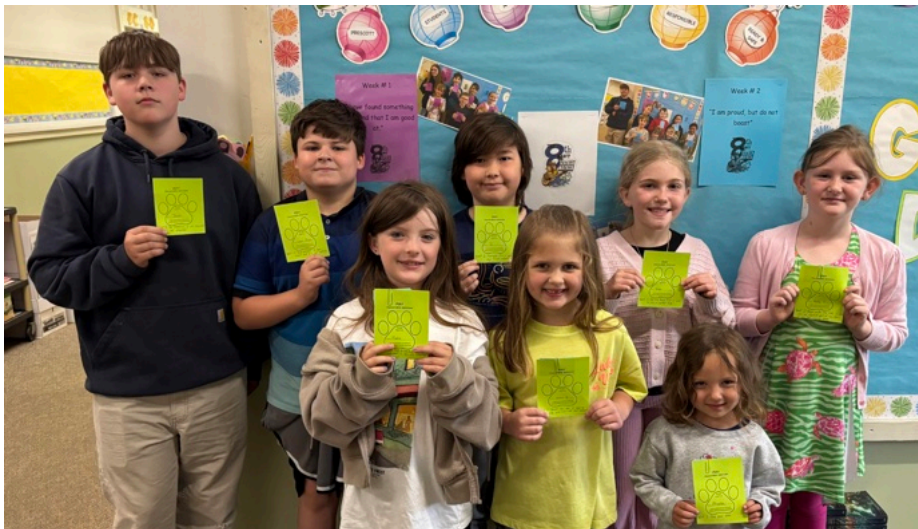
The deadline for turning in unwanted pictures or payment for the pictures you want to keep is June 8th.
