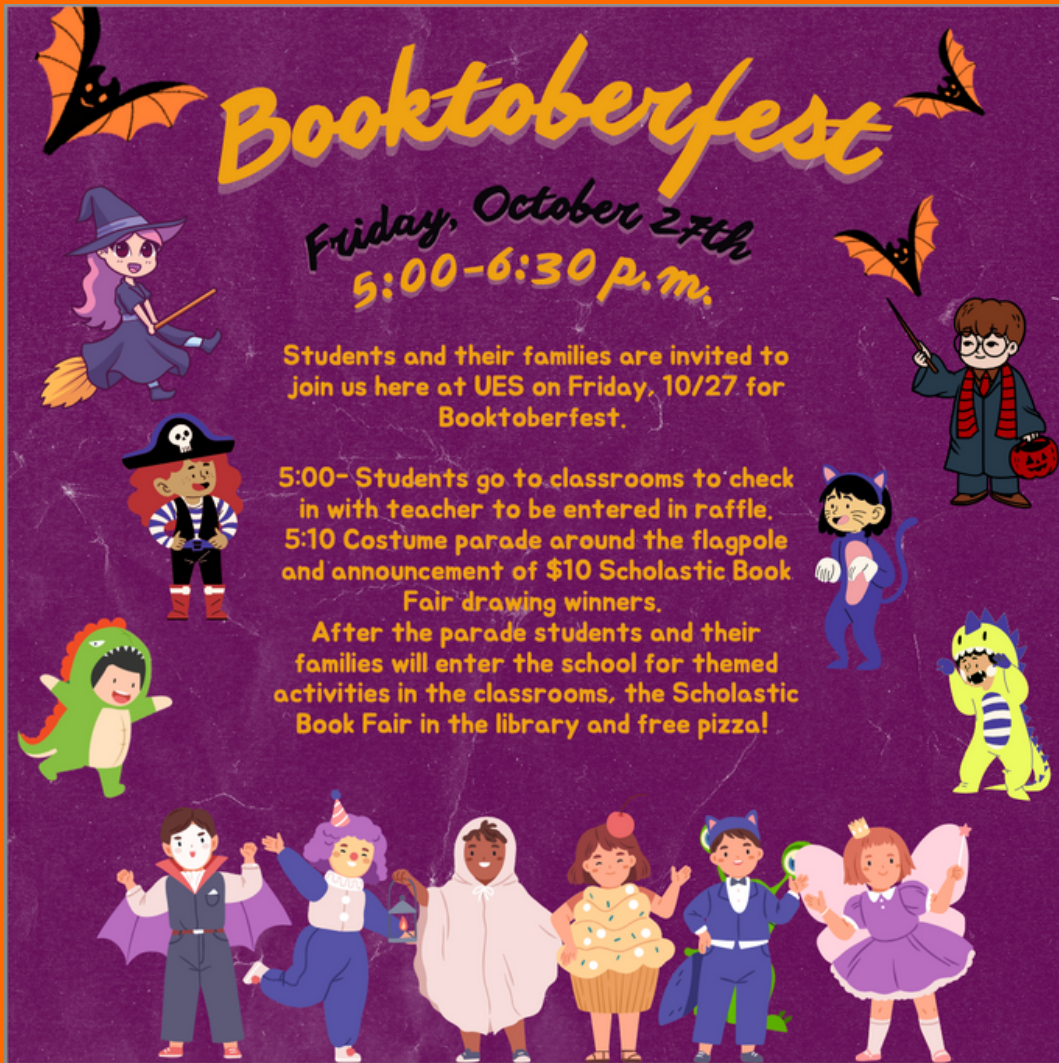


UES PTC Meeting
