Expulsion of Students

A student may not be expelled from school except by action of the Board. The Board may expel students as provided in 20-A MRS § 1001 (8A), (9), and (9A thru 9D). The Board may readmit an expelled student on satisfactory evidence that the behavior, which was the cause of the student being expelled, will not likely recur.

During an expulsion, students are not permitted on school grounds to attend any cocurricular activity, extra-curricular activity, dances, or other school-sponsored activities, or for any other reason without the specific permission of the Superintendent.

Students in Preschool Programs

Children attending public preschool may not be unenrolled, nor asked not to return, without being afforded the due process standard for expulsion in accordance with the above instructions.

RSU 40 may not unilaterally determine that a child attend on a modified schedule, e.g. reduced school day, reduced school week. Parents must be involved in, agree to this decision, and understand thoroughly the reasons for the request.
