Principal's Desk

On Monday, March 27, the Budget Committee of the RSU40 School Board heard the last presentations about cost centers. They began discussing the full budget, but delayed a vote to wait for information about insurance costs and negotiations with support staff.

An important piece of their discussion was about a proposed bond to complete vital facilities projects. The bond could include money to renovate and add an addition to Miller School, along with needed upgrades to the parking lot and playground. It also includes money for an upgrade and addition to Medomak Valley High School.

Further discussion on the budget will take place on Monday, April 10 at 6:30 at the Central Office or online. Some information may also be discussed at the scheduled full Board meeting on Thursday, April 6 at MVHS at 7:00.

2023-2024 Pre-K & K Registration



Pre-K Information:

We currently have three Pre-K programs in our district located at Miller School, Union Elementary School, and Warren Community School. At this time, students attend two days a week. Each Pre-K program is full when it reaches 32 students.

Next year we are anticipating expanding our Pre-K programs to four elementary schools: Miller School, Union Elementary School, Warren Community School, and Prescott Memorial School. Students would attend school five full days each week. Union and Prescott would be full when reaching 16 students. Miller and Warren would be full when reaching 32 students. Friendship students will have the option of being transported to one of our other four elementary schools.

The Pre-K expansion plan depends on our school budget passing. We will have a better sense if there will be a five-day-a-week program or will remain the two-day-a-week program that we currently have in Miller, Union, and Warren after our Board budget vote on April 6th. A child must be four years old on or before October 15, 2023, to be eligible to register for Pre-K.

Priority will be given to students who live in our school district. We will notify out-of-district requests at the end of May.

Kindergarten Information:

A child must be five years old on or before October 15, 2023, to be eligible to register for Kindergarten. If your child was already enrolled with the district for Pre-K, you do not need to do a new registration for enrollment for Kindergarten. You will need to do the annual update of Student Information in the fall.



Medomak Valley Little League 2023

Registration Deadline April 2nd

Little League Registrations are NOW OPEN! Please note, that the DEADLINE for registration this year is April 2nd.

Registrations for the 2023 Little League Baseball/Softball/T-Ball season for Waldoboro and Friendship players of Medomak Valley Little League will be accepted Mon-Thurs, 9:00am-5:00pm, at the Waldoboro Recreation Department until April 2nd.

Little League requires a parent or legal guardian to present a state-certified copy of their child's birth certificate and three proofs of residence (returning players are exempted unless address has changed). Registration is required even if the child played previously. Registration fee is \$40. Scholarships are available upon request for those in need.

Eligibility birth dates are as follows: T-Ball/Baseball born between 9/1/10 & 8/31/19 and T-Ball/Softball born between 1/1/2010 & 12/31/18. Divisions of play include: T-Ball (Ages 4, 5 & 6 coed), Minor League Softball & Baseball (ages 6*-11 Coach & Player Pitch), & Major League Softball & Baseball (Ages 9-12). *League age six-year-olds wishing to play in the Minor League division must have played at least one year of T-ball.

To be selected to a Major League Team, players (ages 9-12) MUST attend a tryout/evaluation session. Players that played on the WILDCATS, PANTHERS, or DIAMONDBACKS in **2022** need to register, but not tryout. This year's evaluations will be held at the Medomak Valley High School gymnasium: Saturday April 1st: Girls Softball (5-6:30pm) & Boys Baseball (6:30pm-8:00pm), and Sunday April 2nd: Girls Softball(5:00-6:30pm) & Boys Baseball(6:30-8:00pm).


